STAMFORD DENMARK FRIENDSHIP RACE

This is a distance race in Long Island Sound sponsored by Stamford Yacht Club of Stamford, CT, the Royal Danish Yacht Club, and the Consulate General of Denmark. The race, which starts south of Stamford harbor, has been since inception a day-race for racing cruisers 21 feet and over. It has become one of the largest such events in the world, in one year attracting more than 300 boats to its dual starting lines. In 2001 a multihull class was added (18 feet and over, with spinnaker), as a separate start. This event has become a key fixture in the sailing calendar of Roton Point Sailing Association.
